Tasting Notes

This Provence style Grenache Noir rosé has aromas of grapefruit and melon with soft floral notes of jasmine and rose. On the palate the wine is very delicate and bright with flavors followed by a crisp acidity and a smooth finish.

Vineyard Notes

Grenache, which is a well established varietal throughout Rhone wine region, as well as Spain, has also found a great home in the Lodi Appellation. Our growers obtain vine balance through the use of shoot thinning, leaf removal, and cluster thinning during the growing season to obtain optimal ripening. This Grenache comes from a vineyard that is farmed by Aaron Shinn. It is located off of Woodbridge rd, almost directly across from the Woodbridge Winery. It is within the Mokelumne River Sub AVA of the Lodi Appellation.

Winemaking Notes

Grapes were hand harvested in the morning and the majority were whole cluster pressed to a temperature controlled stainless steel tank. The remaining portion were de-stemmed and crushed to bin for 24 hours to achieve desired color extraction. The juice was racked and fermented in a stainless steel tank. After a long fermentation, the wine was racked and held cold until it could be finished for an early bottling to maintain freshness and liveliness.
