


OF OAK FARM *Vineyards*

2019 Zinfandel

Lodi, California



Tasting Notes

This Zinfandel is bold in color and has aromas of ripe blueberry, cedar, and red raspberry. Earthy characteristics like autumn leaves, and mushrooms intertwine with black pepper, and licorice on the palate. This wine is velvety with a structured and smoky finish.

Vineyards Notes

All of these grapes were hand picked from 3 separate vineyards in the morning and then gently hand sorted and de-stemmed. They were then transferred to a temperature controlled stainless steel tank for a cold soak. The must was then inoculated and fermentation was done in tank with regular timed pump overs. The wine was then pressed and transferred to oak barrels where it received 9 months of aging. It was aged in 40% new French and American Oak and the remaining barrels were neutral oak. Before bottling the vineyard lots were combined with 10% Petite Sirah.

Winemaker Notes

All of these grapes were hand picked from 3 separate vineyards in the morning and then gently hand sorted and de-stemmed. They were then transferred to a temperature controlled stainless steel tank for a cold soak. The must was then inoculated and fermentation was done in tank with regular timed pump overs. The wine was then pressed and transferred to oak barrels where it received 9 months of aging. It was aged in 40% new French and American Oak and the remaining barrels were neutral oak. Before bottling the vineyard lots were combined with 10% Petite Sirah.
